This application is to issue a new water share to convert:

- A water share to a water share with a different water system; or
- A take and use licence into a water share; or
- An interstate entitlement into a water share.

This application can also be used to issue a water share where permanent water savings have been made in a water system.

Using water on land

Allocation derived from the water share can be used on the land (water-use licence or registration) that is linked to the ABA without directly linking the water share to the water-use licence or registration. You can link your water-use licence or registration to and ABA using Form 40, and in some circumstances Form 24.

Direct link to the water-use licence and registration

This form can be used to directly link a water share to a water-use licence or registration. Please note a water share does not need to be linked directly to a water-use licence or registration.

Allocations

By linking a water share to an allocation account you are applying to have future allocations from the water share deposited into that account. If you are not named on this ABA, you are giving future allocation to the holder(s) of that account under a standing assignment.

Lodging the application

All owners of the water entitlements to be converted into the new water share must sign this application. Where water shares are being issued for water savings all new water share owners must sign this application.

Companies must attach an ASIC company extract that is less than 12 months old. Two directors or one director and secretary are required to sign.

Incorporated associations must attach an incorporated association extract that is less than 12 months old. The listed secretary is required to sign.

The water corporation will notify the water share owners and the lodging party by letter of the new water share when the application has been processed

What is happening under the *Water Act 1989*

This form is an application, where applicable, for the Minister's approval to:

- Issue a water share (under section 33L);
- Associate a water share with land (under section 33AQ);
- Give a standing assignment (under section 33TA);
- For holders of interstate water entitlements to apply for a water share (under section 33M); and
- Obtain a particular place of take approval (under section 64FZJ).
